## 2008 Counselor-In-Training Information Sheet

Thank you for applying to be a Counselor-In-Training (CIT) for the 2008 summer camping program. The CIT program is an important part of the overall camping program. YOU can be an integral part of it all!!

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

- The Kamp Kaleo office must receive a completed CIT application by **May 1, 2008**.
- New letters of reference must be received each year.
- You must turn the required age before camp begins.
- You must attend the training event held at Kamp Kaleo.
- Directors choose their staff members; you must be asked by a Director to be on staff

### **PROCEDURE:**

**Apply by May 1.** We will refer your application to the Director of the camp(s) for which you have indicated preference. The Outdoor Ministry Committee asks that you staff only ONE camp this summer, rather than taxing your energy staffing two camps, perhaps you might attend another camp as a camper.

**Attend the camp training event held prior to your camp.** You must attend this training event to be a CIT this summer, regardless of any previous training you've had. Camp Directors will lead this event with camp policy information presented by the camp administrator.

**Confirm with the Camp Director that you are on staff.** You must attend the pre-camp training meeting.

### **TRAINING:**

The Counselor-In-Training (CIT) position is an opportunity for a person to gain experience in Christian camping and you work in a supervised training setting.

1. All CIT's must attend the training session held by the Director prior to camp.
2. All CIT's will also attend the daily staff meeting that will be held each morning during camp.
