

Registration Information

A minimum deposit of \$50 must accompany each registration. No registration will be accepted over the phone without minimum deposit. Full payment is due 30 days prior to start of your camp.

Registration deadline is April 15th.

Financial Assistance: Many congregations provide camperships to assist youth to attend camp. There is some campership assistance available through Kamp Kaleo. Contact Kamp Kaleo (308) 346-5083 for more information.

Refunds: Cancellations will be accepted up to three weeks before the start of the camp for which you are registered. Money will be refunded minus a \$30 administration fee for each canceled registration. Part time registrations are not accepted.

Health Forms

All camp participants must bring a completed Health Form to camp. The health form is mailed out to every camper with a letter confirming registration. All medications will be left with the camp nurse. Medications should be in their original containers: camper's names and instructions must be included.

In compliance with the 2003 Federal Government Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act, this medical form will be available to the camp nurse and the camp administrator as deemed necessary. Additional professional medical personnel will see this form only in the event of treatment. The camp will retain this form for future reference as needed. Any copies made for off-site activities, will be transported in a sealed envelope and shredded after the safe return from the activity.

Arrival and Departure Times

All campers are asked to arrive between 3:00 and 4:00 p.m. on the first day of camp. Registration will not begin until 3:00 p.m. Please do not arrive before 3:00. Pick up campers at 1:00 p.m. the final day.
